Conclusions on the Delft side on Tshwane - Delft - projects

1. Sister city agreement

The agreement of November 1999 between Delft and Pretoria will be continued without any further changes between Tshwane and Delft. The Tshwane City Council (TCC) will confirm this in a letter. The Delft City Council (DCC) will react positively by letter.

2. Town Planning Project.

- a. TCC will make a decision on the proposal to do an integrated planning project for the Eerste Fabrieke location. The planning will be done in the form of a seminar with workshops with expertise from TCC and DCC.
- b. TCC will collect relevant information concerning the site, relevant TCC-studies and applicable laws and regulations. This includes formal rulings about citizens participation.
- c. TCC will make inventory about functions, that could be continued on the location either because they are standard (e.g. schools/number of inhabitants) or because they still have to be located in Mamelodi.
- d. DCC will make a seminar/workshop proposal (time, place, goals, programme, etc.) In order to safeguard that the outcome of the seminar has the commitment of the politician, their involvement in the seminar-programme needs to be clear. Also the involvement of citizens requires special attention!
- e. DCC will make a proposal for the composition of the "Dutch team" and the preferred disciplines on the Tshwane side. The people/disciplines selected this way, will in principle both take part in the seminar/workshop activities and will form the team that will work together in setting up and further developing the Eerste Fabrieke area.
- f. It is important to actually start as soon as possible. The seminar/workshop can be seen as the formal start. It is important to see that this start is made at the latest early June.

3. Self-building for women

- a. DCC selects in co-operation with Sanco and in consultation with TCC an operational projectmanager from the community.
- b. TCC makes in co-operation with that projectmanager a businessplan for the project, including, next to usual things like quantities, timeplanning, parties involved etc., information about: financial regulations for educational programmes, required budget and income etc.
- c. DCC proposes a financial contribution for the shortage of budget (if any).

4. Arts and crafts, jobs for women

- a. TCC makes an inventory of women, which could participate plus the arts and crafts to be involved.
- b. TCC makes an inventory of possible leaders/managers of the project.
- c. DCC makes a proposal for an educational "business programme" for the woman.artists and for the leaders(s) managers.
- d. DCC does survey in The Netherlands to figure out if there are any shopping **chains** who would want to help with a kick-start of the programme, possible internationalisation of the project and take part in the educational programme.
- e. TCC will make a plan for the restoration of the rondevalls and will make an inventory of restoration funds to be discussed with DCC. On this historical site it seems possible to establish a tourist shop, a workshop, restaurant and an information centre.
